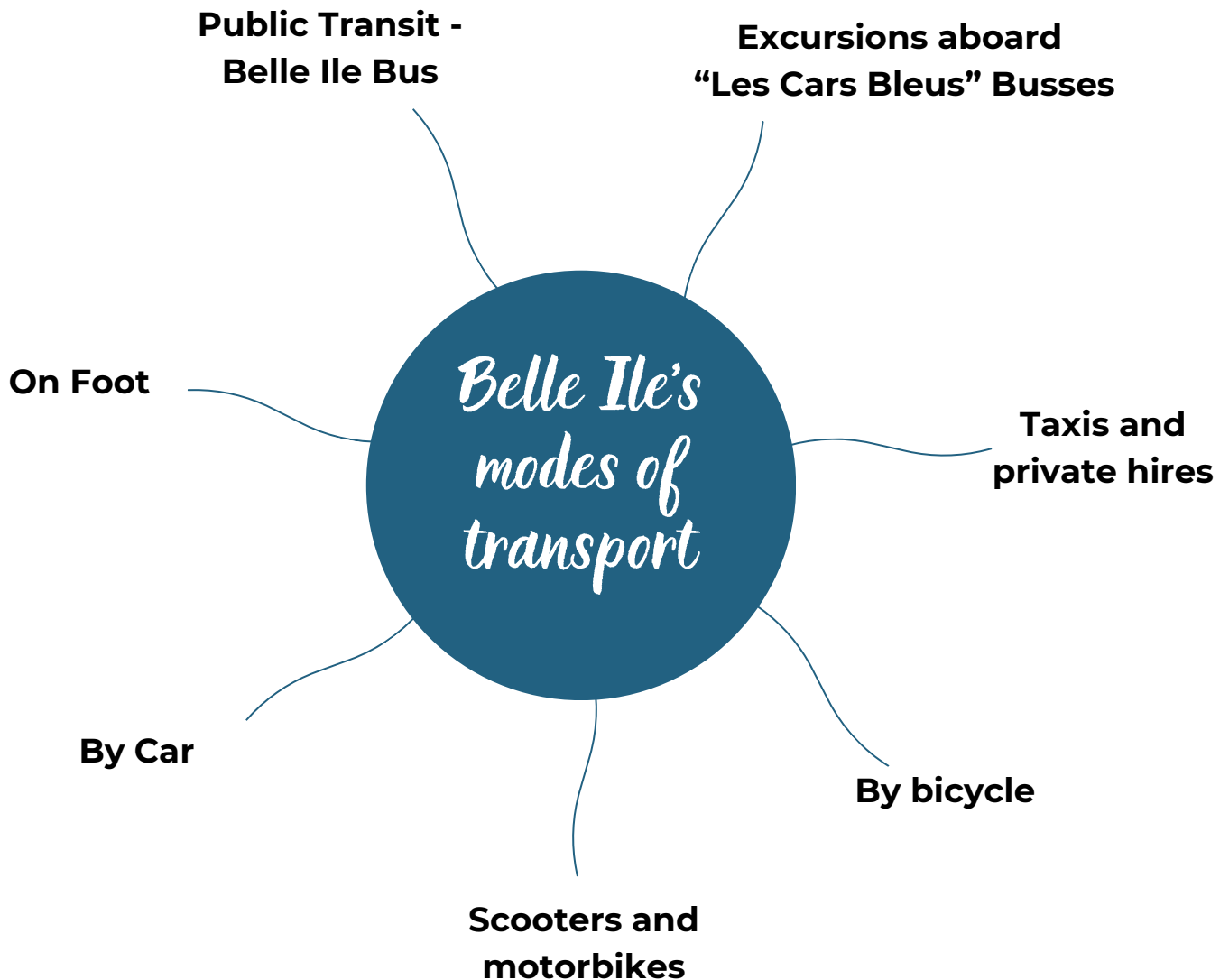




*Getting about on Belle Île
without your car*



Belle-île-en mer is Brittany's largest island, spanning 20 kilometers from East to West and 9 km from North to South.

Belle-île's roads are narrow, winding, unlit (outside of towns), and shared. In short, these are roads where vigilance, respect for others, and foresight are essential for safe travel.

On foot, walk on the left and at night, wear a reflective vest and carry a light.

By bike, follow the bike routes, respect the rules of the road, wear a helmet and use lights.

By car, be vigilant, remain patient and watch out for cyclists and pedestrians.

Belle-Île Bus is a public transit service that operates from Easter to All Saints' Day, serving most villages, accommodations, touristic sites, beaches, and activity locations.

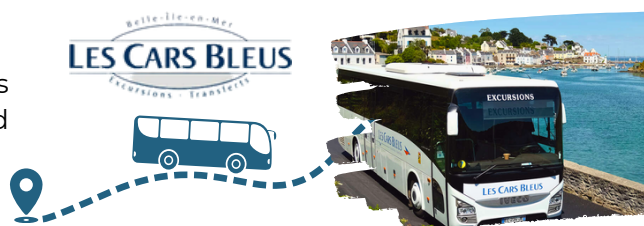

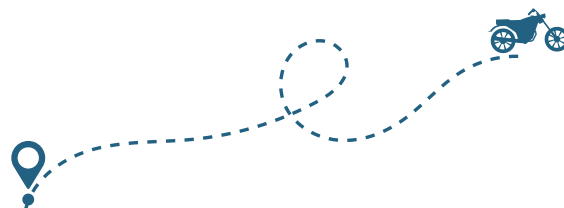

A bit faster than bicycles, some rental providers also offer scooters and motorcycles: electric or petrol-powered, the choice is yours!

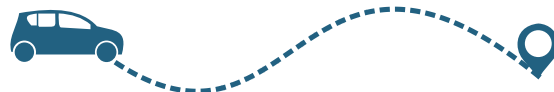

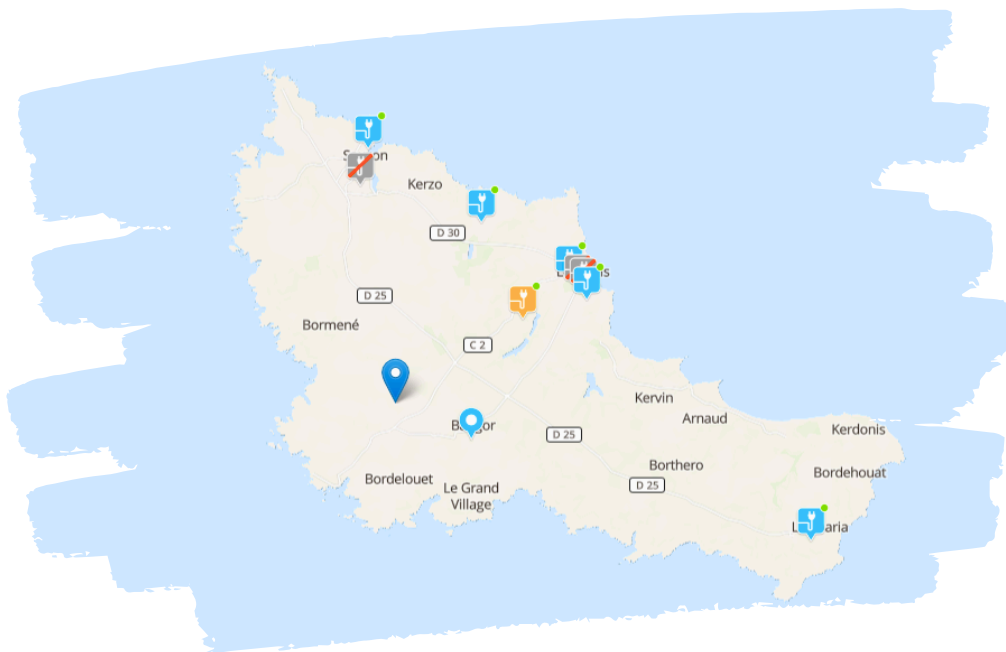
